IN THE MATTER OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 14

On this the 7th day of May 1928 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, at a special session thereof, the returns from a election held in Gemmen

School District No. 16 of Titus County Texas, on the 7th day of April 1928 for the purpose of determining whether the resident property taxpaying, voters, of said District desired to increase, the special school tax of said district to a rate of seventy Five cents, on each one hundred Dollars, of property valuation of taxable property within said districts, for the purpose of supplementing the state School fund apportioned to said District.

After canvassing said returns and determining that at said election there were 17 votes cast, and that 15 votes had been cast in favor of said tax and two votes had been cast against said and ascertaining that said election had in all respects been held according to the law governing such elections Commissioner King made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lindsey that the results of said election be declared in favor of said tax and that seventy cents on each and every one hundred dollars valuation of taxable property in said districts be levied assessed and collected for the year 1928, and for each and every year thereafter until such tax is increased diminished or abrogated according to law.
