It appearing to the Court that on or about the 22nd day of Feb 1928, this Court passed an order authorizing the issuance of \$30,000 Titus County Funding Warrants and provided therein among other things that Warrants Nos. 1 to 11 inclusive should be delivered in exchange for the surrender and cancellation of certain warrants and scrip described in said order;

And it further appearing to the Court that on or about March 28, 1928, this Court, passed a follow up order providing for the delivery of \$10,000 of such funding warrants in exchange for the surrender and cancellation of a like amount of scrip warrants, described in such follow up order;

And it further appearing to the Court that Numbers 1 to 10 inclusive of such warrants have been delivered in exchange for the surrender and cancellation of the list of scrip contained in said follow up order;

It is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the Court that the delivery of said warrants nos. 1 to 10 inclusive in exchange for the surrender and cancellation of the list

of scrip contained in said follow up order be and the same is hereby ratified and approved.

It is further ordered that so much of said original order as provided for the delivery of Warrants Nos. 1 to 11 inclusive, in exchange for the warrants and scrip contained in said original order be and the same is hereby repealed, and it is ordered by the Court that any undelivered warrants of said Titus County Funding warrants provided in said original order may be executed and delivered in exchange for a like amount of the Warrants or scrip described therein.
