

FOLLOW-UP ORDER

COUNTY OF TITUS....

On the 31st day of May 1928, the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas was convened in Special session at the regular meeting place of said Court, all members thereof being present, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

WHEREAS, heretofore on the 22nd day of Feb. 1928, the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, passed an order authorizing the issuance of \$30,000 Funding Warrants for the purpose of funding a like amount of outstanding scrip and warrants against the General Fund of said County, and for the further purpose of funding warrants issued in payment of valid indebtedness incurred, in the construction of improvements and purchase of materials, and other expenses incurred under the provisions of the laws of the State of Texas, and the acts of the Legislature referred to in said order, which order is recorded in Book 4 page 394 of the Minutes of said Court:

And Whereas, in pursuance of said order, the following listed original scrip and warrants against the General Fund of Titus County has been issued in payment of claims which were duly audited and allowed by the Commissioners Court of said County prior to the issuance of such scrip, which scrip constitutes valid, subsisting, and binding obligations against Titus County, being described as follows, to-wit:

THEREFORE, Be It Ordered, adjudged and Decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas:

That said original warrants against the General Fund of Titus County, herein listed be and the same are hereby in all things adjudicated and held and declared to be valid, subsisting binding and unsatisfied obligations against Titus County, and the acts of the County officers in the issuance of said Warrants are hereby in all things ratified and confirmed.

It is further ordered that in conformity with said warrant order, passed on the 22nd day of Feb 1928, Titus County Funding Warrants, to the amount of \$6000 of an issue of \$30,000, of the denomination of \$1,000 each, dated March 10, 1928, bearing interest at the rate of 6% per annum, be executed and delivered to the First National Bank of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, the owner and holder of the original warrants herein listed, upon surrender and cancellation of said original Warrants, and that the balance of \$_____ be carried forward as a credit toward an additional installment delivery of such warrants.

It is further ordered that E.L. Myers, County Judge be and he is hereby authorized and directed to deliver said warrants to the amount of \$6000 to the First National Bank of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, when the original Warrants to the amount of \$6000 herein listed, have been surrendered to him and cancelled, said funding, warrants to be delivered to said Bank in lieu of and in full satisfaction of said original warrants.
