IN THE MATTER OF MAKING A MAP OF THE CITY OF MT. PLEASANT TEXAS.

On this the 9th day of July 1928 at a regular monthly meeting of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with all members thereof present, came on to be considered by the Court the matter of co-operating with the City of Mt. Pleasant, and the Mt. Pleasant, Independent School District in having a map made of the City of Mt. Pleasant, so that each and every lot and building in the City may be definitely located and its owner determined in order that no property in said city may escape rendition for taxation. After discussing the matter in connection with representatives from the City Council, and ascertaining that a great deal of property in the City of Mt. Pleasant, is now escaping taxation and that a proper map of the City would avoid such condition and be of benefit to Titus County, Commissioner Olds made a motion seconded by Commissioner King that Titus County pay one third of the Cost of making said map but that the amount to be paid by Titus County not exceed \$500.00 The County judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote aye and those opposed to vote NO. All Commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the County judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF ADVANCING J.T. LEFTWICH advancement of \$150.00 for expenses in assessing taxes.

On this the 9th day of July 1928, came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court the request of J.T. Leftwich tax assessor of Titus County, Texas, for an advancement of \$150.00 for the purpose of paying expenses in assessing the Taxes, after discussing the request Commissioner Luna made a motion seconded by commissioner King, that the said Leftwich be advanced \$150.00 out of the Jury fund. The County judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote aye and those opposed to vote NO all Commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the County judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the matter of a public Road Beginning about one mile East of the Meadows Curve on public Road leading east from Meadows Curve Thence in a northeasterly direction following the Old Goolsboro and Harts Bluff to Where it intersects the Harris Chapel Road at Pads Chappel.

On this the 9th day of July came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, the petition of W.E. Wilson, and more than seven other freeholders in commissioners pre No. 3 of Titus County Texas, praying that a public Road be granted beginning about one Mile East of the Meadows Curve on public Road leading East from Meadows Curve Thence in a NE direction following: the old Goolsboro and Harts Bluff to Where it intersects the Harris Chapel road at Pads Chapel. Commissioner King made a motion seconded by Commissioner Olds that said petition be granted and the road established, The County judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO all Commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the County judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
