On this the 13th day of August AD 1928 at a regular meeting of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, came on to be considered the petition of D.D. Traylor and more than seven other freeholders of Commissioners Pre No. 4 of Titus County, Texas, prayed that a public Road be granted beginning at the SW Cor of Hays Johnson place being known as the Old Charley Parham place, thence East to Morris County line. After considering said petition Commissioner Olds made a motion seconded by Commissioner King that said road be granted as prayed for the County judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO" all commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the County judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF TAX RENDITION FOR D.D. TRAYLOR,

On this the 13th day of August 1928, came on to be considered by the commissio.es court the matter of the rendition of D.D. Traylor and after considering the matter and ascertaining that there is more land in his farm and the assessors rolls shows but that said farm has been rendered for a fair and reasonable amount commissioner Olds made a motion seconded by commissioner Lindsey that the valuation of said farm be accepted by the court as it has been heretofore rendered and that the surplus acreage not shown by the assessment be discharged from any tax lien whatever. The County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote Aye, those opposed to vote No. All commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
