 IN THE MATTER OF PURCHASING MIDWAY SCHOOL BONDS

On this the 10th day of Sept AD 1928 the commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, convened at the Court of the County thereof, with commissioners Lindsey, Luna, King, and Old present and E.L. Myers, County Judge present and presiding and with W.E. McClintock County Clerk and ex-officio Clerk of the commissioners Court present, when came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court the matter of investigating the money on deposit belonging to the Titus County permanent School Fund, and after ascertaining that Midway Common School No. 11 of Titus County Texas, has and offered for sale 16 bonds against said district for the principal sum of \$100.00 each of the aggregate sum of \$1600.00 when commissioner Lindsey made a motion seconded by Commissioner Old that said bonds, be purchased by the said permanent school fund, the County judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO" all commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the County judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

 IN THE MATTER OF RE-IMBURSING JOHN WHITE FOR MONEY SPENT IN SANDING WHITE OAK BOTTOM AND WILLOW OAK FLAT:

ON This the 10th day of Sept AD 1928 the commissioners Court of Titus County continuing in regular session, when came on to be considered by said Court the matter of re imbrursing John White for money spent in sanding White Oak Bottom and Willow Oak flat, and after discussing the matter and ascertaining the fact that the original appropriation was insufficient to do said work and the said White had expended his own funds to the extent of \$22.50 Com. King made a motion seconded Com. Luna to pay to the said White \$22.50 out of the Road and Bridge fund to the amount of \$22.50 The County judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO Commissioner King, Luna, and Old voted in the affirmative Commissioner Lindsey voted in the negative and the County judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
