Commissioners Court in Special Session at the Court House in the town of Mt. Pleasant, Texas on this the 7th day of May AD 1929, with the following present John Wilson, Lawrence Bowden, Charlie Harvey, and Thurman Wilbanks, Commissioners and E.I. Lazarus, judge presiding, when came on to be considered the proposition of exchanging land with Common School District No. 8 Titus County, Texas, wherein the County desires a right of way of 100 feet across the lands belonging to said District for public road purposes, and

Commissioner John Wilson proposed that Titus County Texas convey and exchange 3-1/2 acres of land out of the E.W. Embors Sur purchased from J.J. Taylor for 2 acres belonging to said School and giving to said School by J.J. Taylor et ux and John Bargrove and wife and move said school bldg to land designated by school board and place it in as good condition as found it and so made to that effect, and same was seconded by Commissioner Thurman Wilbanks

The County judge placed said motion before the said Court saying that all voting for said motion to say "AYE" and opposed "NO" and Commissioners John Wilson, Thurman Wilbanks, Charlie Harvey and Lawrence Bowden voted AYE and none voted NO and the County judge declared said motion carried, and

It is now the order judgment and decree of this Court that said exchange be made and that the Commissioners Court by its four members together with the County judge make said School District No. 8 a warranty Deed conveying to them said 3-1/2 acres of land which is fully described and metes and bounds in deed executed by said County to said School District to which reference is hereto made for a description of same by field notes.

Commissioner Wilbanks introduced a proposed order and made a motion that it be passed.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner Wilson.

The motion was carried by the following vote:

AYES: Commissioners Wilbanks, Wilson, Bowden, and Harvey.

NOES: None.

The County judge announced that the order had been finally passed. The order as passed is as follows, to-wit:

Whereas, the Commissioner's Court passed an order on the 10th day of Dec 1928, providing for the issuance of General Funding Warrants, in the amount of \$25,840.00 for the purpose of funding and refunding, an equal amount of interest bearing time warrants and scrip of said County theretofore duly and legally issued for general expense purposes; and

Whereas, the following interest bearing time warrants are now outstanding and unpaid, all being eligible for inclusion in the refunding, issue above described, which warrants, are described as follows, to-wit:

(a) Titus County Funding Warrants, dated March 10th, 1923, Nos 16 to 20 in the denomination of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars each aggregating Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars.

(b) Titus County Funding Warrants Dated May 10th 1923, Nos 1, to 15, in the denomination of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, each, aggregating Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars.

(c) Titus County Funding Warrants, Dated Jan 5, 1921, Nos ___ to ___ in the denomination of \$_____ Dollars, each, aggregating Three Thousand (\$3,500.00) Dollars,

and

Whereas, there is now outstanding and unpaid certain legally issued scrip chargeable against the general fund of the County, eligible for inclusion in the refunding issue above described, being more particularly described as follows:

Whereas, the warrants and scrip above described aggregate the sum of \$22,840.00 all of which warrants and scrip were legally issued and are now outstanding against the general fund of said County, the claims for which were duly audited, approved and allowed by the Commissioners Court prior to the issuance of said Warrants and Scrip, which are to be surrendered and cancelled, and the general refunding, warrants, Series, 1928-A are to be issued to the holder or holders of said warrants, and scrip in lieu thereof, as provided in the order authorizing the issuance of Titus County Funding Warrants Series

1928 A, passed by the Commissioners Court of said County and of record in Vol. 4 page 432 of the Minutes of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, that the County Judge County Clerk and County Treasurer, be authorized and directed to receive from the holder or holders thereof, the said \$22,840.00 above described warrants and scrip and to issue in lieu thereof to said holder or holders warrants Numbers One (1) to Twenty Three (23) of Titus County Funding Warrants, Series 1928-A, in the denomination of \$1,000.00 each, except No. 1 for \$840.00 aggregating the sum of \$22,840.00. That simultaneously with said exchange of said securities, the said officials shall cancel said above described warrants and scrip and shall make any and all certificates necessary to properly establish the legality of said Funding Warrants.

The County Judge announced that the order had been finally passed. The order as passed is as follows, to-wit:

Whereas, the Commissioner's Court passed as an order on the 22nd day of Feb 1928, providing for the issuance of Funding Warrants in the amount of Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.00)

Dollars, for the purpose of funding certain Scrip and time warrants chargeable against the General Fund of the County, and for the purpose of funding, an equal amount of warrants of said county duly and legally issued for general purposes, which order was amended

by an order passed Dec 10, 1928, and

Whereas, heretofore the Commissioner's Court of Titus County, has by proper order, authorized the delivery of Titus County Funding Warrants Series 1928, numbers one (1) to Twenty Nine (29) inclusive, in lieu of a like amount of legally issued and outstanding scrip and time warrants of said County and

Whereas, certain Scrip eligible for inclusion in the funding issue aggregating one Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, has been duly and legally issued and is now outstanding against the general fund, the claim for which was duly audited, approved, and allowed by the Commissioner's Court prior to the issuance of said Scrip warrants, and which is to be surrendered and cancelled and the remaining General Funding Warrant, Series 1928, is to be issued to the holder of said Said general Fund Scrip Warrants, in lieu thereof as is provided in the order authorizing the issuance of Titus County Funding Warrants, Series 1928, passed by the Commissioner's Court of said County on the 22nd day of Feb 1928, as amended by order passed Dec 10, 1928,

Therefore, be it ordered by the Commissioner's Court of Titus County, Texas; That the County judge County Clerk and County Treasurer be authorized and directed to receive from the holder or holders thereof the scrip warrant as follows:

That the County judge County Clerk and County Treasurer issue in lieu thereof to said holder warrant Number Thirty (30) of said Titus County Funding Warrants, Series 1928, in the denomination of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, that simultaneously with said exchange of securities of the said officials shall cancel said above described original scrip warrant, and shall make any and all certificates necessary to properly establish the legality of said refunding warrant.
