

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT ON THE 12th day of Aug AD 1929 was begun and holden a regular term of the commissioner's Court of Titus County Texas with the following officers present to-wit: Hon E.I. Lazarus County Judge R.T. Willbanks, H.C. Hurvey Jno A. Wilson, and L.O. Bowden Commissioners and W.R. Whitaker Clerk of said Court. with the following proceedings were had to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF REPORT OF JURY OF VIEW;
TO THE HON. COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS COUNTY TEXAS;

The undersigned jurors, duly summoned and acting under and order of this Court, made on the ___ day of July 1929, after having taken the oath as required by law, and on the 12, day of August 1929 proceeded to lay out, Survey and describe a road to the greatest advantage of the public and so that the same may be traced with certainty which road is situated in Titus County Texas south of Mt Pleasant, and changes, the Mt Pleasant, and Pittsburg, public right road as follows: commencing on Cypress Creek at the end of the recently constructed state highway leading from Pittsburg in Camp County Texas, north to Big Cypress Creek where the new bridge recently was constructed, being Station No. 635 plus 50 Thence with center line 50 feet on each side of said center line for a total width of 100 ft., said center line running North 16° & 10 Min W. a distance of about 10,715 feet Thence continuing on N. 12° & 30' W. a distance of about 7,764 feet to the intersection of the Mt. Pleasant & Pittsburg highway and continuing on in the same direction a distance of 601 feet to the end or termination of said proposed new road at station No. 822 plus 27.5,

which proposed new road is East of the St. Louis Southwestern Railway Co., of Texas, right of way The line above referred to being the center line for the said right of way and the WB line of the S.M highway will be 50 ft. W. of said center line and the EB line of said above described line will be 50 ft. East of the said Center line.

And after having given five days notice in writing by legal notice upon John Byrd and his wife, Mrs. John Byrd, S.D. Murphy and his wife, Mrs. Bulah Murphy, Vern Adams and Mrs. W.V. Pope and husband W.V. Pope of Titus County Texas and Mrs. Leta Harrell a single woman, and Mrs. W.B. McCaskel and her husband W.B. McCaskel of Idabel, Okla., and Mrs. E.E. Starks and her husband E.E. Starks of Terrent County Texas and G. C. Hopkins of Camp County Texas, and Claude Adams of Blythe California, the owners of land thru which said road runs, and they having presented to us statements of the damages claimed by them respectively which are returned with this report, we assessed their damages as follows:

G.C. Hopkins of Camp County for value of land taken the sum of \$115.00 And for amount of damages to land not taken the sum of \$_____

To Jno Byrd & wife Mrs. Jno Byrd for value of land taken the sum of \$300.00 For damages to land not taken the sum of \$450.00

Mrs. W.V. Pope, Vern Adams, Mrs. Leta Harrell, Mrs. W.B. McCaskel Mrs. E.E. Starks and Claude Adams, as the whole surviving heirs of the estate of Dr., and Mrs. Adams, both deceased for land taken the sum of \$180.00 For damages to land not taken the sum of \$_____ And we apportioned the said damages among the said Adams heirs in equal shares, that is to say, a one sixth of the said damages to each of the above named Adams heirs. \$30.00 each

To S.D. Murphy and wife Mrs. Bulah Murphy for land taken the sum of \$1000.00 And for damages to land not taken, the sum of \$300.00

All of which is respectfully submitted for the further orders of this Court.

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING FOR THE MT. PLEASANT & PITTSBURG HIGHWAY RIDEWAY

Commission Wilson made a motion seconded by Commissioner Harvey to pay G.C. Hopkins (\$115.00) for the said Rideway crossing his property in Titus County The County judge put the motion before the Court--all--with the request as many as favored said motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO" all voting in the affirmative and the County Judge declared the motion carried the order passed.

Commissioner Wilson, made a motion seconded by Wilbanks to pay John Byrd \$370.00 (for 14.8 acres of land at \$25.00 per acre) for said roadway crossing his property in Titus County The County judge put the motion before the Court with the request as many as favored said motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO all voting in the affirmative and the County judge declared the motion carried the order passed.

Commissioner Wilson made a motion seconded by Harvey to pay Adams heirs \$270.00 for said roadway crossing their property in Titus County The County judge the put the motion before the Court with the request as many as favored said motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO all voting in the affirmative and the County judge declared the motion carried the order passed.

Commissioner Wilson made a motion seconded by Bowden to pay Murphy and wife \$100.00 per acre for 7.47 acres of land making \$747.00 for the land and \$300.00 damages for the said roadway the County Judge put the motion before the house as many as favored said motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO all commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative and the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

ORDER ESTABLISHING ROADS

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

OF TITUS COUNTY TEXAS, at a regular Session Thereof.

On this the 13th day of Aug AD 1929 came on to be heard the report of the jury of view appointed to lay out and survey a change in the Mt. Pleasant, and Pittsburg public road so changing the same in Titus County that the new purported road 100 feet wide shall begin at the bridge over Big Cypress Creek built at the terminus of the new road in Camp County upon the land of Geo. C. Hopkins and on the G.C. Hopkins RR Survey at Station No. 635 plus 50 for center line of the said 100 feet right of way and the said center line of said right of way to extend and run Thence N. 16' & 10 Min. W. at a distance of 10,715 feet Thence continuing on N. 12' & 30 Min., W a distance of about 7,764 feet to the intersection of the purported new road with the Mt. Pleasant, and Pittsburg highway as it now exists and continuing on in same direction a distance of about 601 feet to the termination of said purported new road at Station No. 822 plus 875, which purported new road is to be laid out so that the WB line thereof shall be 50 ft., from said center line above described and that the EB line shall be 50 feet distant from the said center line above described, and the said report having been in all things considered together with all objections made to the said report by the land owners thru whose land the same pass it is ordered by the Court that the said report be approved; that said road is hereby established and the field notes of said Survey and description of said road is hereby established and adopted as the highway of the Mt. Pleasant, and Pittsburg road as changed by the report of the jury of view and it is further ordered that the said report be recorded in the Minutes of this Court.

It is further ordered that there be allowed and paid as damages and as adequate compensation for the land taken for said road to the several owners thru whose land the said purported changed and new road shall extend the amounts of money as follows; to-wit

To G.C. Hopkins of Pittsburg.....\$115.00
 To Jno Byrd and wife of Titus County \$370.00
 To the Adams Heirs.....\$270.00

Which shall be apportioned and allowed to the several owners thereof in equal shares, that is to say, the same shall be divided in equal shares among Mrs. F.V. Pope, Vern Adams, Mrs. Leta Harrell Mrs. W.B. McCaskel Mrs. E.E. Sterke and Claude Adams, To S.D. Murphy and wife Mrs. Bulah Murphy \$1547.00 And the said sums of money so allotted and allowed as damages and adequate compensation to the above named parties shall be paid by Titus County to the said parties respectively or be deposited to their credit with the County Treasurer of this County and the County Clerk of Titus County, Texas is hereby ordered and directed to issue the warrants, of Titus County on the road and Bridge fund of said County payable to the said parties and deposit with the County Treasurer money out of said Road and Bridge fund for each party as above set out the amount therein stated, which shall be subject to the Check or demand or call for the person in whose favor it is deposited.

It is further ordered that the said new road be and it is hereby classified as a road of the first class, it being a change made in a first class road and known as a part of the Jefferson highway, and the said new Road hereby directed to be laid out shall be under the
