IN THE MATTER OF PAYING ACCOUNTS;

Commissioner Bowden made a motion to pay all bills as checked and found correct and same was seconded by Com. Harvey. The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored the motion so vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all being present and voting in the affirmative, the Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF EMPLOYING A COUNTY AGENT;

All Commissioners Wilson, Wilbanks and Harvey voted "AYE" and Commissioner Bowden voted "NO". The Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
