

BE IT REMEMBERED, that on the 14th day of April there was begun and holden a regular term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas with the following officers present, towit: E.I.Lazarus County Judge, Commissioners Wilbanks, Bowden, Harvey and Wilson, and W.R.Whitaker Clerk of the Court, when the following proceedings were had:

Commissioner Wilson made a motion seconded by Commissioner Bowden to pay Mrs. S.D.Murphy \$25.00 for a desk for the Home Demonstration Agent. The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All voted in the affirmative and the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

Commissioner Wilson made a motion seconded by Com. Bowden to give the County Judge authority to enter into contract with private party to collect insolvent delinquent taxes said contract to be approved by the State Comptroller, The Co. Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All voted in the affirmative and the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

Commissioner Wilbanks made a Motion seconded by Commissioner Bowden to appoint L.H. Wilson to fill the unexpired term of John A. Wilson deceased, as Commissioner and J.P. Preet # 3 Titus County, The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All voted in the affirmative and the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF THE REGISTRATION AND APPOINTMENT OF CONSTABLE OF PREET # 3.

Commissioner Harvey made a motion seconded by Commissioner Wilbanks to except the registration of C.P. Kelley and appoint C.E. Burkham in his place as Constable of preet # 3. Then County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All voted in the affirmative and the Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
