After cafefully examining the bills that were presented to the Court and after due consideration, Commissioner Harvey made a motion seconed by Commissioner Wilson to pay said bills. The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all the court being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

It being called to the attention of the Court that J.D.Smith is a pauper and and is unable to clothe and feed himself and that he has no relatives that can do so, Commissioner Lilly made a motion seconed by Commissioner souden pay said J.D.Smith \$5.00 per month out of the Titus County pauper funds. The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "BO". All being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

Commissioner Lilly made a motion second by Commissioner Bowden to discontinue paying Mrs. John Smith as a pauper. The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as an many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "BO". All being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

Commissioner Wilson made a motion accound by Commissioner Lilly to pay the various County officers of the County who are entitled to Exofficio salerys, the same as they were paid last year. The County Judge put the motion Defore the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all the Court being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

BN THE MATTER OF BOARD BILL FOR PRISONERS

Commissioner Bowden made a motion sesoned by Commissioner Harvey to cancle seid warrant and order the County Clerk to Issue another in place of said lost warrant. The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "ATE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge Seclared the motion carried and the order passed.
