On this the 2, day of Feb 1931 came on to be considered by the Commissioner Court of Titus County, Texas the matter of guaranteeing unto the State mighway Commission of Texas the securing within a reasonable time, or when demand is made upon it by said mighway Commission, of that additional right of way not already secured for widening of State Highway # 65 in Titus County, and of certifying to

secured for widening of State Highway # 65 in Titus County, and of certifying to said Highway Commission the fact that all assments for right of way and relocation of said State Highway # 49 has been secured complete; and,

Whereas, the right of way between Mt.Pleasant, and Harts Creak necessary for the

relocation of State Mighway # 49 has been secured completely by purchase and condemnation; and,

Wherees, all right of way on State Mighway # 65 for widening thereof to 100 feet; has been secured with the exception of about three small parcels yet to be secured; and,

Whorees, it appears certain that said exceptions will be secured and one be secured in the near future.

How, Therefore, it is ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that the County Clerk of Titus County Texas certify to the State nighway Commission of Texas the fact that all right of way for the re location of State nighway \$ 49 as aforesaid to a width of 100 feet has been secured and that work may be hegun

ensame and that for the widening to 100 feet on State "ighway \$ 65 has been secured except two or three small parcels and to guarantee, and the said Commissioner's Court does now guarantee by this order unto the said State "ighway Commission of Texas that all proper ty necessary to complete widening of State Mighway \$ 65 in Titus County inorder to make seme 100 feet wide will be accured and acquired by the said Commissioners Court of Titus County within a reasonable time, or upon demand being made for same by said Mighway Commission, to the end that work on the underpass and the work on projects for \$ 65 will ge forward immediately.

Commissioner's Court of Titus County Texas and was duly secured by Commissioner Wilson,
The County judge put the motion before the members of said Commissioner's Court for a wote
with a request that as many as favored same to vote AYE's and those opposed therate to vote
NO* all of said commissioners woted AYE the County judge declared the motion carried and
the above order passed.
