

IN THE MATTER OF HIGHWAY No 49 and 65

On this the 2, day of Feb 1931 came on to be considered by the Commissioner Court of Titus County, Texas the matter of guaranteeing unto the State Highway Commission of Texas the securing within a reasonable time, or when demand is made upon it by said Highway Commission, of that additional right of way not already secured for widening of State Highway # 65 in Titus County, and of certifying to said Highway Commission the fact that all assessments for right of way and relocation of said State Highway # 49 has been secured complete; and,

Whereas, the right of way between Mt. Pleasant, and Harts Creek necessary for the relocation of State Highway # 49 has been secured completely by purchase and condemnation; and,

Whereas, all right of way on State Highway # 65 for widening thereof to 100 feet has been secured with the exception of about three small parcels yet to be secured; and,

Whereas, it appears certain that said exceptions will be secured and can be secured in the near future.

Now, Therefore, it is ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that the County Clerk of Titus County Texas certify to the State Highway Commission of Texas the fact that all right of way for the relocation of State Highway # 49 as aforesaid to a width of 100 feet has been secured and that work may be begun

onsame and that for the widening to 100 feet on State Highway # 65 has been secured except two or three small parcels and to guarantee, and the said Commissioner's Court does now guarantee by this order unto the said State Highway Commission of Texas that all property necessary to complete widening of State Highway # 65 in Titus County in order to make same 100 feet wide will be secured and acquired by the said Commissioners Court of Titus County within a reasonable time, or upon demand being made for same by said Highway Commission, to the end that work on the underpass and the work on projects for # 65 will go forward immediately.

Commissioner Bowden made a motion that the above order be passed and adopted by said Commissioner's Court of Titus County Texas and was duly secured by Commissioner Wilson, The County Judge put the motion before the members of said Commissioner's Court for a vote with a request that as many as favored same to vote AYE and those opposed thereto to vote NO all of said commissioners voted AYE the County Judge declared the motion carried and the above order passed.
