

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 9th day of March A.D. 1931 there was begun and holday a regular term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with the following officers present, to-wit: Commissioners Harvey, Wilson, Bowden and Lilly, W.R. Whitaker Clerk of the Court and R.T. Wilbanks County Judge presiding, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF COUNTY SECURITIES

Commissioner Bowden made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lilly that the Guaranty Bank State Bank of Mt. Pleasant, Texas be ordered to turn over to the First National Bank in Mt. Pleasant, Texas the following securities, to-wit: \$11,200.17 Titus County Common School District Vouchers, \$72,74.42 Mt. Pleasant Independent school District Vouchers, Total \$ 18474.59, which are now held by the said Guaranty Bond State Bank in trust for the said Titus County. The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All the Court being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING ACCOUNTS

Commissioner Bowden made a motion seconded by Commissioner Wilson that the accounts as presented to the Court be allowed and ordered paid. The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING COUNTY DEPOSITORY BOND

On this the 9th day of March A.D. 1931 came on to be considered the matter of approving the bond of the First National Bank in Mt. Pleasant as depository for the County and school funds. The said bond being and consisting of the following.

The amount being for school funds ordered approved by the Court. The County depository bond for County funds being Walker County Special 5 % Road Bonds \$60,000.00 on deposit in the Republic National Bank of Dallas to the credit of Titus County. The amount being accepted and approved by the Court with the order that 1st. National Bank put up additional \$25000.00 bond at once making a total of \$80,000.00.

IN THE MATTER OF ISSUING WARRANTS TO J.D. ADAMS CO.

Commissioner Bowden made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lilly that the Court order the County Clerk to issue time warrants to said Co. for the balance due them. The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All being present and voting in the affirmative the Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF CONDEMNING HIGH TWAY ON HIGHWAY NO 65

It appearing to the Court that they had exhausted all means of securing the required Right-of-way on Highway No. 65 through the Gamble property. Commissioner Wilson made a motion seconded by Commissioner Harvey that said land be condemned and that a Jury of View of three disinterested men be appointed to assess the damages to said property. The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favor said motion

to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF PUBLIC ROAD Near Amerson's

On this the 9th day of March AD 1931 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas application of A.J. Luna and others for a public road when commissioner Bowden made a motion seconded by commissioner's Harvey to grant the following road a public road beginning at the NE Cor of the Amerson Tract of land and near the residence of J.W.Cody and running due South on the land line between Smiths and Amerson's tract of land and intersecting the Highway at Walter Sarretson's S.W.Cor a distance of about 3/4 mile said road to be 30 ft wide.

County judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as approved said motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO" all voted AYE motion carried with the understanding the people change and remove and set back all fences on said road.

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING A.P.Williams \$450.00 out of the M&B Fund for 50 ft of right of way.

It is further agreed that the said A.P.Williams, shall move all buildings and obstructions, at his own expense be it further understood that a quorum was present at said meeting consisting of Commissioner Bowden Harvey, Willson, and Lilly. County judge put the order before the house with the request that all approving said order to vote I opposed No County judge declared order carried.

Pleasant, Texas the following securities, and to wit: \$45,000.00 Walker County Special 5% Road bonds, which are now held by said Republic Nat'l Bank and Trust Co of Dallas Texas in Trust for the County of Titus.

Be It further remembered that a quorum was present consisting of commissioners, Bowden Harvey Wilson and Kily the above and foregoing order was passed in open Court with the above named members present on this 9th day of March, AD 1931.
