

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 13th day of April A.D. 1931 there was begun and holden a regular term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County with the following officers present, to-wit: R.T.Wilbanks present and presiding, Commissioners Wilson, Lilley, Bowden and Harvey and W.R.Whiteaker Clerk of the Court when the following proceedings were had:

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING MRS. MATTIE DAVIS \$5.00

It appearing to the Court that Mrs. Mattie Davis is in destitute circumstances Com. Wilson made a motion seconded by Com. Lilley to pay said Mrs. Davis \$5.00 out of the pauper fund. The Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that all that favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All being present and voting in the affirmative the Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER CANCELING SCRIBE

IT APPEARING TO THE Court that a General County Warrant issued to R.T.Thigpin in 1930 in the sum of \$3.00 has been lost or destroyed, Commissioner Harvey made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lilley to cancel said warrant and issue one in its stead. The Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All being present and voting in the affirmative the Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER BORROWING MONEY

Commissioner Lilley made a motion seconded by Commissioner Bowden to borrow \$1250.00 from the C.H.& J fund for the Pauper fund. Then County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All being present and voting in the affirmative the Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF BORROWING MONEY

Commissioner Lilley made a motion seconded by Com. Harvey to borrow \$1000.00 from the R & B fund for the R & B Int. and sinking fund. The Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All being present and voting in the affirmative the Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF CLOSING ROAD.

THE FOLLOWING petition was presented to the Court:
