

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 21st day of May A.D. 1931 there was begun and holden a special term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, County, with the following officers present R.F. Wilbanks Judge, Commissioners Harvey, Wilson, Lilley and Bowden and W.R. Whitaker Clerk of the Court when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF EXCHANGING BONDS WITH B.F. DITMAR:

Commissioner Lilley made a motion seconded by Commissioner Bowden to exchange \$5000.00 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ % Titus County Special Road Bonds maturing April 1932 for \$5000.00 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ % Titus County Special Road Bonds No. 541 maturing 1941, No. 546 maturing 1942 and Nos. 575, 576 and 577 maturing 1943. These bonds being owned by the Titus County permanent School fund and exchange to be made through the First National Bank in Mt. Pleasant, The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All being present and voting in the affirmative the Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
