IN THE MATTER OF THE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 1931

Commissioner Bowden made a motion seconded by Commissioner Wilson set the tax for the year 1931 as follows:

All being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF FANS IN THE JURY ROOM AT THE JAIL AND IN THE COURT ROOM AT THE COURTHOUSE

Commissioner Lilley made a motion seconded by Commissioner Harvey to put fans in the jury room at the Jail and in the Court Room at the Court house. All the Court being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF HEALTH PROGRAM

Commissioner Wilson made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lilley to hire Mr. Johnnie Mathews at a salary of \$100.00 per month to aid the State department of Health in putting over a health program in Titus County. All the Court being present and voting in the affirmative the Judge declared motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

The board of Equalization in session on this date agreed to meet again on the 22nd day of July to hear complaints of those cited by the board to show why their tax rendition should not be raised.

IN THE MATTER OF DELINQUENT TAXES ON THE JOSEPH MALEY SURVEY

On this the 29th day of June AD 1931 at a called session of the Honorable Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas when came on to be considered the question of delinquent taxes on the Joseph Maley RR Sur Abat No 400 Situated in the North part of Titus County Texas

and on the Waters of Sulphur River in that it was made known to the Court that during the assessment of said land for taxes that same was placed on the rolls of the tax rolls of Titus County Texas at an unfair value in some places as high as \$10.00 per acre and the Court was shown that land in the vicinity and had been assessed at around \$5.00 per acre which is a fair value of said land in question and it was further made known to the Court that the taxes interest and penalty on said survey had amounted and had run up to more than the cash market value of the land in question.

So the Court after hearing said facts above relative is of the opinion that said taxes be adjusted in order to do right between the owners of said land and the Taxing powers of State County and School District.

So a motion was made by Charlie Harvey and Second by L.H. Wilson Commissioners, that the Tax Collector of Titus County be authorized directed and empowered to cancel all outstanding delinquent taxes against said 160 acre Sur of land and to re assess same at a value of \$5.00 per acre and not to include any penalty and interest for the years that same may show delinquent from 1908 to 1930 both years included where not paid And said motion was placed before said Commissioners Bowden, Lilly, Wilson and Harvey, by the presiding County judge Mr. Wilbanks, and requested all favoring said motion to vote aye and those opposed NO and same was placed before same body and Wilson Bowden Lilly and Harvey voted AYE and the County judge declared said motion carried and ordered same spread upon the minutes of this Court.
