

HE IT REMEMBERED that on the 3rd day of August AD 1931 there was begun and helden a special term of the Commissioners Court of Titus Co nty, Texas with the following officers p resent R.T.Wilbanks, County Judge, Commissioners Ha rvey, Wilson, Lillen and Bowden and W.R.Whitaker Clerk of the Court when the following proceeding were had, to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF LOENDING MONEY TO THE REVOLVING FUND OF MALARIA CONTROLE WORK

Commissioner Wilson made a motion seconded by Commissioner Bowden to loan \$100.00 to the revolving fund to be used in financing the screening of helmes in the Malaria controle work being done in this County By the State and Federal Government. The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All being present and voting in the affirmative the judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
