Whitaker Clerk of the Court when the following proceeding were had, to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF BUYING NEW INDEX FOR THE COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE.

It appearing to the Court that the County Clerk's officieris badly in need of some new index, Commissioner Bowden made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lilley to buy 4 volumes of Gotto Index from The Dorsey Company as per samples shown the Court. The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all the Court being present and voting in the affirmative the Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF APPOINTING JUSTICE OF THE PEACE FOR PRECT # 5

It appearing to the Court that R.A. Lawler, Justice of the Peace of Prect. # 5 is dead, Commissioner Lilley made a motion seconded by Com. Bowden to appoint L.M. Geck to fill said vacancy. IN THE MATTER OF ROBERT BELL PAUPER

The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All being present and voting in the affirmative the Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
