The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO". All being present and foting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

After a careful canvasm of the above trustee election returns it appears to the Court that Tundy Pynes received 57 votes and Bud Williams received 53 votes. Commissioner Bowden made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lilly that Tandy Pines be declared elected as School Trustee of said School District No. 6. The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO." All being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judga declared the motion carried and the order passed.
