All being present and voting in the affirmative the Judge declared the motion carried and order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF CANCELING LOSE WARRANT

It appearing to the Court that Warrant No. 4217 issued Nov. 18th 1931 is lost or misplaced. Said warrant was issued to H.B.Kelly in the amount of \$3.00. Commissioner Wilson made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lilly that said warrant be canceled and that another warrant be issued to replace same.
