

IN THE MATTER NEW INDEX TO REPLACE OLD ONES.

Commissioner Bowden made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lilly to let the following contract for indexing.

THE STATE OF TEXAS -  
COUNTY OF TITUS

WHEREAS, the Commissioner's Court of Titus County, Texas sitting in a regular session this the 12th day of Dec. A.D. 1932, which Court is composed of Hon. R.T. Wilbanks County Judge, L.O. Bowden Commissioner Preet. # 1. H.C. Harvey Commissioner Preet. # 2. L.H. Wilson Commissioner Preet. # 3 and A.S. Lilly Commissioner Preet. # 4. when came on to be considered the matter of employing some competent person to re-index certain Deed Records of Titus County, Texas, and,

It appearing that the Court has received certain proposals for the completion of such indexing among one of which was from the Dorsey Company for the sum of \$3745.00; it further appearing to the Court that a proposal from W.B. Wright for the sum of \$1920.00 was the lowest proposal received for the completion of such re-indexing.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the said Commissioners Court employ W.B. Wright to reindex such deed records which consists of 68 Volumes, (33 Bound Books and 35 Loose-Leaf Books) for such sum of \$1920.00 which shall be paid to him in the sum of \$160.00 on the first of each month beginning January 1st. 1933 out of the Court House and Jail Maintenance Fund, for the term of 12 months, which amounts to the sum of \$1920.00, for the completion of such contract, the said W.B. Wright to receive all cards after the re-indexing is completed.

W.B. Wright is to supply the proper Clerical help, typewriters and should any additional indexing cards be needed, he is to furnish same, in fact Titus County is to be at no other expense than the said sum of \$1920.00. W.B. Wright is to begin at once and rush such work to the completion as speedily as possible taking precaution to make complete and accurate entry of each and every record.

In addition to re-indexing such records, the said W.B. Wright is to furnish Titus County two cloth maps, (ownership maps of Titus County, showing the location thereon the School Districts of the County as practicable as possible, allowing for the conflicts which are to be shown thereon, Such work to be completed as soon as possible.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that such contract be accepted and the Clerk is ordered to issue to W.B. Wright voucher drawn against the Court House and Jail Maintenance Fund on the first of each month beginning with January 1st 1933 for the sum of \$160.00 and that said W.B. Wright is directed to begin work at once and rush same to completion as speedily as possible.

IN THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS COUNTY TEXAS

AT THE REGULAR TERM DEC 1932.

On this day came on to be heard and considered in the Commissioners court of Titus County, Texas, in regular session at its 4th term 1932, the fixing of the terms of the County court for civil and criminal business, as authorized and empowered under article, 5, sec., 29 of the state constitution of Texas, and it appearing to the said Commissioner's Court that the arrangements now made and under which the said Court has been sitting for several years is every inconvenient and difficult to keep up with and conflicts with other Courts in the

County and that it would be to the best interest of the officers, the attorneys and litigants having business in said court to rearrange the terms so as to have each regular term of said court to convene on the first Mondays in Jan, March, May, July, Sept. and Nov of each year and remain in session until Saturday night before the convening of the next succeeding term.

It is therefore considered, ordered adjudged decreed and ordained by the County Commissioner's Court of Titus County Texas that beginning with Jan 1st, 1933 and from that date thereafter continuously until changed by the order of this court the terms of the county court for civil and criminal business in and for Titus County Texas shall be as follows:

to wit:

There shall be held in and for Titus County Texas each year six terms of the said County Court for civil and criminal business; the several six terms shall begin as follows: the first Monday in Jan, March, May, July, Sept and November of each year and each of said terms of said court shall continue until Saturday night next immediately before the beginning of the next ensuing term. During each of said terms and throughout the entire time thereof any civil or criminal business may be tried in the said court and the terms herein and hereby created and assigned are in lieu of and in place of the terms fixed by the Constitution, and this order is made in compliance with and to carry into effect the provisions of Sec 29, of Article 5 of the Constitution of Texas.

The clerk of this court is directed to record this order upon the Minutes of this court and it shall be in force and effect from and after Jan 1st, 1933 until changed by order of this court or the Legislature of the State of Texas, as the case may be. Commissioner Cowden made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lilly that the above and foregoing order be passed the county judge put the motion before the court with the request that all favored said motion to vote "AY" and those Opposed to vote "NO" all being present and voting in the affirmative the judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
