Motion by Lilly seconded by Blankenship to effect County Judge's salary to be reduced from \$175.00 to \$160.00 per month motion put before the Court and all voted AYE the judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF REDUCING THE SHERIFF'S EXOFFICIO

Motion by Blankenship seconded by Lilly to reduce Sheriff's Exofficio from \$41.66 to \$35.00 per month motion put before the court and all voted in the affirmative the judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF REDUCING THE COUNTY CLERK'S EXOFFICIO:

Motion by Blankenship seconded by R.L.Thomas, to reduce Exofficio of County Clerk from \$62.50 to \$55.00 per month motion put before the Court and all voted in the affirmative the judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF REDUCING THE SHERIFF'S BOARD BILL:

Motion by Lilly seconded by Thomas to effect Sheriff's board bill be reduced five cents per meal from the present rate of 50 cents per day for boarding prisoners who all in jail motion put before the court and all voted in the affirmative the judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF REDUCING THE JANITOR'S SALARY

Motion by Blankenship seconded by Lilly to effect Janitor's salary be reduced from the present salary of \$60.00 to \$50.00 per month the motion was put before the Court and all voted in the affirmative the judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
