

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT on the 8th day of May AD 1933 there was begun and holden a regular term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas with the following officers present to wit:- Hon A.J. Luna County judge and presiding thereof, L H Wilson, R.W.Blankenship, A.S. Lilly, R.L.Thomas, Commissioners and Jack Cross Clerk of said Court; when the following proceedings were had to wit:-

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING ELMER HOLLAND AND FAMILY TEN DOLLARS PER MONTH:

Motion made by L.H.Wilson and seconded by Commissioner Lilly for Titus County to help Elmer Holland and family to the amount of Ten Dollars, per month, and at this time issue Mr. Holland a check of Fifty Dollars which would equal to five monthly payments. The said fifty Dollars is to be paid out of the Pauper fund. Motion put before the Court and all members being present and voting in the affirmative the county judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING PINK WILSON TEN DOLLARS OUT OF THE PAUPER FUND:

Motion by Commissioner Lilly and seconded by Commissioner Thomas for Titus County to help or contribute to Mr. Pink Willson, the sum of ten Dollars five dollars to be paid on this date and the other five to be paid at the July Term of the Commissioners Court. The said ten dollars is to be paid to Mr. Willson from the pauper fund. All members being present and voting in the affirmative the county judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

The above and foregoing minutes read and approved in open Court.
