Motion by Commissioner, Wilson and seconded by Thomas, for this court to record the act
of the Court of March 13, of this year, with reference to the petition to change the road
from Roy Nelson to the Highway at Cookville, The Court is now of the opinion that the old road
should be kept open for travel, as the petition for the new road was not migned by theland
