Motion by A.S.Lilly and seconded by R.W.Blankenship for the property tax rate for the County in behalf of the different funds to be as follows; for year 1933.

- Jury fund.....15c
- Road and bridge interest & Sinking fund 15c
- General County..... 12c
- General Co Int., & Sinking fund..... 13c
- special RAB Int., & Sinking fund \$1.15
- Road and bridge fund, nothing

Motion put before the Court and all members being present and voted in the affirmative the county judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
