All members being present voting in the affirmative the county judge declared the motion carried and the order passed. IN THE MATTER OF TRANSFERING \$335.00 from the Court House and Jail Fund to the pauser fund. Motion by L.H. Wilson and Seconded by A.S.Lilly for the Commissions ra Court to transfer from the Court house and Jail fund \$335.00 to the Titus County Pauper fund for the paupers of maintaining and kesping County paupers All members being present and voting in the affirmative Motion carried and the order passed. IN REGARD OF DISCONTINUE THE TELEPHONES AT COURT HOUSE: Motion by R.W.Blanksnship and Seconded by A.S.Lilly for the commissioners Court to discontinue the telephones service also the slectric light service those expenses have been paid heretofol rs out of the Court House and jail fund therefore the Court has been restrained from using said fund The discontinuation of the above purpose shall take effect Sept 30, motion caried and

the order passed. A

Continuation of above motion Also discontinue the water service at the Court house and the

public toilet at the Court house shall be closed on the above date. All members voting in the affirmative. Motion carried and the order passed. IN THE MATTER OF BEER LICENSE MONEY.

Motion by R.W.Blankenship and second by R.L.Thomas, for the County Treasuer to deposit the Beer License money into the Titus County operating fund subject to be withdrawn by order of Commissioners Court Motion put before the Court and all members voting in the affirmative Motion carried and the order passed.
