

BE IT REMEMBERED That on the 10th day of Sept AD 1934 there was begun and holden a regular session of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, in the City of Mt. Pleasant, Texas with the following of officers present to wit; Hon A.J. Luna County Judge Commissioners, R.W.Blankenship, Commissioner L.H.Wilson, A.S.Lilly, and R.L.Thomas, and Jack Cross Clark. with the following proceedings were had to wit;

THE STATE OF TEXAS) IN THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS COUNTY,
COUNTY OF TITUS....) TEXAS, IN REGULAR SESSION THIS 10th Day of Sept AD 1934.

WHEREAS, in Cause # 3365 in the District Court of Titus County, Texas wherein W.R. Whitaker, was plaintiff and the County Commissioners Court and Geo. W. McLeMore, Treasurer, and the several county Commissioners were defendants, on the 8, day of June AD 1934 the said Honorable District Court of Titus County, Texas made its order and entered its judgment in said cause against A.J. Luna, County Judge, R.W. Blankenship, R.L. Thomas, A.S. Lilly and L.H. Wilson, composing the County Commissioner's Court of Titus County, and Geo. W. McLeMore County Treasurer of Titus County, in part as follows; to wit:-

"The said County Commissioner's Court and Geo W. McLeMore Treasurer of Titus County, are commanded to transfer the sum of \$4086.49 now in the County Treasury in the fund denominated General County Interest and Sinking Fund' back into the general county fund and that the portion of the said sum that arose from the collection of taxes in 1932 be set aside to pay any script legally issued against that fund in 1932 for current expenses of that year; that the portion of the said sum that arose from the levy, assessment and collection of taxes in the year 1933 be set aside into a fund with which to pay the County Script issued for the year 1933 for account of expenses accruing in that year, and no part of the general county taxes levied for 1933 be hereafter used for any other purpose than the payment of the current expenses of said county for the year 1933 until all of such current expenses are paid." And therein further ordered specifically as follows;

" It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the portion of the \$4086.49 now in the Treasury in the fund designated County General Interest and Sinking Fund " that arose from the collection of taxes for 1932 shall be used to pay the unpaid current expenses that accrued in 1932 in the order in which the same was audited and registered, and the said County Commissioners Court and Geo. W. McLeMore, Treasurer, are hereby ordered to pay the plaintiff's claims that come within the limit of the funds for 1932 in its order according to its registration.

" It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the claims of Plaintiff that accrued in 1933 be by Geo. W. McLeMore, and the County Commissioners Court of Titus County paid in its registration order out of the portion of said County general interest and sinking funds that arose from the levy, assessment and collection of taxes for the year 1933.

Whereas, the said judgment and order of the Honorable District Court of Titus County as aforesaid has never been appealed from and no appeal was taken therefrom; therefore, it is hereby ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that the said sum of \$4086.49 now in the Treasury of Titus County, in the fund denominated General County Interest and Sinking fund"

accrued in the years 1932 and 1933 in the following proportions, to wit; for the year 1932 \$2,404.49 for the year 1933 \$5,875.27

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed by the County Commissioner's Court that the County Treasurer Geo. W. McLemore Transfer the said money into County General Fund for the year 1932 in the amount above stated and for the year 1933 in the amount above stated.

It is further ordered that the script issued for the current expenses of Titus County for the year 1932 in order of its registration number shall be paid out of the said fund for the year 1932 as above set out, and the script issued for current expenses of Titus County for the year 1933 shall be paid out of the said fund for 1933 in order in which said script accrued was issued and registered.

It is further ordered that a copy of this order, duly certified under the seal of said Court and the had of the Clerk of the County Court of Titus County, be delivered to the said Geo. W. McLemore, Treasurer of Titus County, for his guidance.
