ORDER OF ELECTION  
TO CONSOLIDATE DISTRICTS

Whereas, on the 29th day of June AD 1935, a petition was presented to me for an election to be held in (a) Lavada Common School District No 27, of this County, on the question of determining whether or not a majority of the legally qualified resident voters of said Common School District No 27, of said County, desire that (a) Lavada Common School District No 27 of said County, shall be consolidated with (a) Talco.Ind., School District No ---of Titus County, for school purposes; and

It appearing that Franklin County contains a population of 8494 according to the last United States Census; and

It further appearing that said (a) Lavada Common School District No. 27 has been heretofore properly established by order of the Commissioners Court as passed on the 15th day of Aug 1893 which order is of record in (c) Book B. page 427 Com Court Records of Franklin Co. Texas.

and it further appearing that said District as so established, contains an area of 7.84 square miles and that no other District has been reduced in area below nine square miles by reason of the creation of this District;

Now, Therefore, I, J.W. Middleton, in my official capacity as County Judge of Franklin County, Texas, do hereby order that an election be held on the 27th day of July AD 1935, at (c) Lavada, in said (a) Lavada Common School District No 27, of said County, as established by order of the (b) Com. Court as passed on the 15th day of Aug 1893, which order is of record in (c) Book B. page 427 Com. Court Records of Franklin County, Texas, to determine whether or not a majority of the legally qualified resident voters of said District desire that (a) Lavada Common School District No 27, of said County shall be consolidated with (a) Talco Independent School Dist No ...of Titus County, for School purposes.

George Wims is hereby appointed Presiding Officer for said Election and he shall select two Judges and two Clerks to assist him in holding the same and he shall, within five days after said election has been held, make due return thereof to the Commissioners Court of this County as is required by law for holding a General Election.

All persons who are legally qualified voters of this State and of this County and who are resident in said District shall be entitled to vote at said election, and all voters who favor the proposition to consolidate the said Districts for School purposes shall have written or printed on their ballots, the words:

FOR CONSOLIDATION\*

And those opposed to the proposition to consolidate the said Districts for School purposes shall have written or printed on their ballots, the words;

Against Consolidation\*

Notice of said Election shall be given by posting three notices thereof in three public places within the boundaries of said District for twenty days prior to the date of said election.
