IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING The County Budgets for 1936.

Motion by Wilson and Seconded by Thomas, that the Budget for 1936 expenditures for Titus County be approved all members being present and voting in the affirmative the county Judge declared the motion carried and the order passeds.

Motion by Stringfellow seconded by Thomas, that according to a law passed by the Forty Fourth

Legislature regulating Salaries of County Commissioners the salary of Titus County Commissioners be set at \$900.00 per year beginning Aug 9, 1935 all members being present and voting in the

affirmative the county judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
