Be it remembered that the Commissioner's Court of Titus County, Texas, met in Special Session at the Court House of said County in the City of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, on Feb. 13th 1936 with the following members present, to wit:

G. T. Neugent, County Judge and County Commissioners, Stringfellow, Thomas, Wilson, and Lunsford.

When County Commissioner L. H. Wilson offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas and made a motion that the same be passed by said court which motion was seconded by County Commissioner H. L. Thomas. The order is as follows; to wit:

"It appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, that it is necessary and for the best interest of said county to purchase the right of way from Franklin County line to intersection with Highway #1, and #49 North of Mt. Pleasant also loop into West first Street as heretofore designated by the Highway Department with the further understanding

that the Highway Department will loan said Titus County the money to purchase the right of way payable in three equal installments and due one, two and three years from date. This order is made with the further provision that the Highway Department will build the loop road from West First Street to the intersection of Highway #1, continuing to direct the traffic on down through Mt. Pleasant and over said loop road, and will not build the Highway from the intersection of Highway #1 and #49 North of Mt. Pleasant to the intersection of said above described loop road for two years or as long as the traffic does not demand the building of same."

The County Judge put said motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with the request that as many as favored the motion would vote "Aye" and those opposed would vote "no". Whereupon County Commissioners L. H. Wilson, Geo. Lunsford, T. J. Stringfellow and R. L. Thomas voted Aye, None voted No. The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
