Commissioner G. C. Lunsford made a motion that the above numbered County Warrants be cancelled which motion was seconded by Commissioner R. L. Thomas. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote Aye, and all opposed to vote No. All members of said Court voted Aye. The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

On this the 12th day of May 1936 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of paying Road Bond No. 23 issued by Road District No. 3 of Titus County, Texas. Said Bond being held by the First National Bank in Mt. Pleasant to secure a loan to Titus County amounting to \$500.00. Said amount of money having been placed in the Interest and Sinking fund of Titus County when received from said First National Bank.

Commissioner G. C. Lunsford made a motion, which motion was seconded by Commissioner R. L. Thomas, that the above Bond #23 be paid out of the Interest and Sinking fund of Titus County. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote Aye and all those opposed to vote No. All of said members voted Aye. The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
