

Be it remembered that on this the 22nd day of June 1230, the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, met in a called session at the Court House of said County in the City of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, with the following members present to wit:

C. T. Neugent County Judge and County Commissioners G. C. Lunsford, T. J. Stringfellow, L. H. Wilson and R. L. Thomas, when County Commissioner L. H. Wilson offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, and made a motion that the same be passed by said court, which motion was seconded by County Commissioner G. C. Lunsford. The order in words and figures is as follows to wit:

It appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that there is a surplus in the Jury Fund of Titus County, and that in order to pay the necessary expenses of the county it is necessary that the sum of \$400.00 be transferred from the Jury Fund of Titus County to the Operating Fund of Titus County.

The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said commissioners court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "No" Commissioner L. H. Wilson, G. C. Lunsford, R. L. Thomas and T. J. Stringfellow all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
