C. T. Neugent County Judge and County Commissioners G. C. Lunsford, T. J. Stringfellow, L. H. Wilson and R. L. Thomas, when the following proceedings were had to wit:

- County Commissioner T. J. Stringfellow made a motion that P. T. Weay be allowed the sum of \$221.00 out of the Permanent Improvement Fund of Titus County for the construction of the Jury Room over the Ladies Rest Room, which motion was seconded by County Commissioner G. C. Lunsford, The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "No" County Commissioners G. C. Lunsford, T. J. Stringfellow, R. L. Thomas and L. H. Wilson all voted "Aye" None voted "No" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

Motion by T. J. Stringfellow that the account of J. A. Davis amounting to \$65.00 be allowed out of the Permanent Improvement Fund of Titus County for the installation of a Drinking Fountain in the Ladies Rest Room which motion was seconded by County Commissioner R. L. Thomas. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "no" All of said Commissioners voted "Aye" None Voted "No" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

Motion by T. J. Stringfellow that the account of C. T. Neugent County Judge for Trial Fees amounting to \$21.00 be allowed out of the Trial Fee fund of Titus County, which motion was seconded by Commissioner R. L. Thomas. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the Request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "No" County Commissioner T. J.
