Be it remembered that on this the 10th day of August 1936 there was begun and helden a regular term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, at the Court House thereof with the following officers present to wit: G. T. Neugent, County Judge, Commissioners G. C. Lunsford, L. H. Wilson, T. J. Stringfellow and E. L. Thomas; Jack Cross Clerk, when the following proceedings were had to wit;

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County the monthly reports and expense accounts of the following named officers to wit:

E. C. Houston, Justice of the Peace of Precinct No. _____ Titus County, Texas, approved.

H. E. Wilhite, Justice of the Peace of Precinct No. 1 Titus County, Texas, expense account approved for \$1950.

Q. C. Gaddis, Sheriff of Titus County, Texas, account approved as filed. Jack Brown J. P. Prec. No. 3, Titus County, Rept. approved as filed.

A. B. Gilpin, District Clerk of Titus County, Texas, expense account approved

as filed.

Motion by Commissioner G. C. Lunsford, seconded by Commissioner T. J. Stringfellow that the above accounts for the month of July 1936 be approved. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote Aye and all those opposed to vote No. All of said members voted Aye. The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

On this the 10th day of August 1936 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, and expense account of Jack Cross, County Clerk of Titus County, for the month of July 1936, amounting to \$213.80, same being an overpayment of excess fees due Titus County for the year 1935 and paid by said Jack Cross to the County Treasurer. County Commissioner G. C. Lunsford made a motion that said expense account be allowed, which motion was seconded by Commissioner T. J. Stringfellow. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Commissioners Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote Aye and all those opposed to vote No. County Commissioners G. C. Lunsford, T. J. Stringfellow, L. H. Wilson and R. L. Thomas all voted Aye. The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

On this the 10th day of August 1936 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County the matter of issuing a duplicate warrant to Dr. A. A. Smith out of the General County Fund of Titus County; said duplicate warrant is to take the place of General County Warrant No. 7675 dated June 14th 1933 and payable to Dr. A. A. Smith of Talco, Texas. When County Commissioner G. C. Lunsford made a motion that a duplicate warrant be issued to take the place of General County Warrant No. 7675 which has been lost, which motion was seconded by Commissioner T. J. Stringfellow. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said commissioners court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote Aye, and all those opposed to vote No. County Commissioner G. C. Lunsford, T. J. Stringfellow, R. L. Thomas and L. H. Wilson all voted Aye. None voted No. The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
