IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING THE MONTHLY REPORTS AND THE COUNTY BUDGET.

Be it remembered that the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, met in a regular session at the Court House of said county in the City of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, on the 14th day of September, A. D. 1935, with the following members present, to-wit:

G. T. Neugent, County Judge, and County Commissioners G. C. Lunsford, L. H. Wilson and R. I. Thomas, then the following proceedings were had to-wit:

On this the 14th day of September A. D. 1936 came on to be considered by the commissioners court of Titus County, Texas, the monthly reports of the following named County and Precinct officers of Titus County, to wit:

E. C. Houston, Justice of the Peace of Precinct. No. 2 and 3 Titus Co.

H. E. Wilhite, Justice of the Peace of Precinct No. 3, Titus County.

Jack Gross Jack Brown, Justice of the Peace of Precinct No. 3, Titus County.

Loyd Graff, Constable of Precinct No. 3, Titus County.

A. B. Gilpin, District Clerk of Titus County.

Q. C. Gaddis, Sheriff of Titus County.

County Commissioner, G. C. Lunsford made a motion that the monthly reports of the above named officers be in all things approved which motion was seconded by County Commissioner R. L. Thomas. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "No" County Commissioner, G. C. Lunsford R. L. Thomas and L. H. Wilson all voted "Aye". The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

On this the 14th day of September 1936, came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of examining the monthly fee reports of the various county and precinct officers of Titus County and for the first eight months of the year 1936, and after a careful examination of said monthly reports, it is the opinion of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that there will be paid into the General County Fund of Titus County by County and Precinct Officers, approximately, \$4500.00 in excess fees for the year 1936.

On this the 14th day of September 1936, the Commissioners Court of Titus County being in session, when County Commissioner, G. C. Lunsford made a motion that the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, recess until 9 o'clock A. M., September 15th., 1936, which motion was seconded by County Commissioner, R. L. Thomas. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "No" County Commissioners G. C. Lunsford, R. L. Thomas and L. H. Wilson all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
