Be it remembered that on this the 9th day of November 1936, the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, met in a regular session at the Court House of said county, in the City of Mt. Pleasant, with the following members present to wit: C. F. Neugent, County Judge and County Commissioners, G. C. Luneford, T. J. Stringfellow, R. L. Thomas and L. H. Wilson, when the following proceedings were had to wit:

On this the 9th day of November 1936 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the resignation of Q. G. Gaddie, Sheriff of Titus County, Texas, when Commissioner G. C. Luneford made a motion that the resignation be accepted, which motion was seconded by Commissioner, T. J. Stringfellow. The County Judge put the motion to a vote

of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "No" Commissioners, Geo. Lunsford, T. J. Stringfellow, L. H. Wilson and R. L. Thomas all voted "Aye". The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

On this the 9th day of November 1936 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the application of G. R. Ard asking to be appointed Sheriff of Titus County, Texas, to fill out the unexpired term of Q. C. Gaddis, resigned, when County Commissioner G. C. Lunsford made a motion that the said G. R. Ard be appointed sheriff of Titus County, Texas, to fill out the unexpired term of Q. C. Gaddis, which motion was seconded by County Commissioner, T. J. Stringfellow. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "No" County Commissioners, G. C. Lunsford, T. J. Stringfellow, L. H. Wilson and R. L. Thomas all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

On this the 9th day of November 1936, G. R. Ard, sheriff of Titus County, Texas, presented an application to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, asking that Sam E. Smith be appointed Deputy Sheriff of Titus County, at a salary of \$125.00 per month. County Commissioner T. J. Stringfellow made a motion that the said Sam E. Smith be appointed Deputy Sheriff of Titus County, Texas, at a salary of \$125.00 per month to be paid out of the fees of said sheriff's office, which motion was seconded by Commissioner, G. C. Lunsford. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "No". County Commissioners T. J. Stringfellow, G. C. Lunsford, L. H. Wilson and R. L. Thomas all voted "Aye" None voted "No" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

On this the 9th day of November 1936, came on to be considered by the commissioners court of Titus County, Texas, the application of U. M. Ard, Sheriff of Titus County, asking that V. D. Tittle be appointed Deputy sheriff of Titus County at a salary of \$75.00 per month. Commissioner, G. C. Lunsford made a motion that the said V. D. Tittle be appointed Deputy Sheriff of Titus County at a salary of \$75.00 per month. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "No" County Commissioners, T. J. Stringfellow, G. C. Lunsford, L. H. Wilson and R. L. Thomas all voted "Aye" None voted "No" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

On this the 9th day of November 1936 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the application of U. M. Ard, Sheriff of Titus County, asking that Billie McElroy be appointed as Deputy Sheriff of Titus County to work in Talco in Precinct No. 3, at a salary of \$100.00 per month, when Commissioner T. J. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and those opposed to vote No. All of said members voted "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
