Session at the Court House of said County in the City of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, on March 8, 1957, with the following members present, to-wit:

Brown.

Commissioner Brown that the Monthly Reports be approved. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the Commissioners Court and the motion was carried unanimously.

Motion was made by County Commissioner T. J. Stringfellow and seconded by County

Motion was made by County Commissioner Geo. Linesford and seconded by County Commissioner T. J. Stringfellow that W. B. Wright be paid \$500.00 out of the General County Fund for compiling index to the Deed Records of Titus County. The motion was put before the Commissioners Court for a vote and the motion carried unanimously.

and the motion was seconded by County Commissioner T. J. Stringfellow:

Motion was made by CountyCommissioner Geo. Lunaford and seconded by County Commissioner T. J. Stringfallow that the monthly expense accounts for February be approved, and

the motion was carried unanimously.

County Commissioner Goo. Lunsford made a motion that the following order be approved

"March 9, 1937.

"Whereas, Titus County, Texas was prepared on October 10, 1936 to pay all unexchanged Hoad District No. 1 5% bonds, dated 5/15/16;

And whereas, the J. R. Phillips Investment Company of Houston, Texas, so notified all known holders of these bonds that funds were available at that time to pay said bonds which matured 4/10/56;

And whereas, no demand for payment of \$8,000 Titus County Road District No. 1 Bonds, Serial Nos. 51/58 inclusive, has been made on Titus County and the owner thereof was not known until January 21, 1937. "And whereas, Bonds Nos. 51 to 52 were to have been exchanged for Titus County Road Refunding 5% bonds dated 4/10/35, which refunding bonds matured 4/10/36;

"Therefore, it is ordered by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas this 9 day of March, 1937 that interest be paid on \$2,000 Road District No. 1 Bonds Nos. 51 and 52 only up to 4/10/56, and only interest be paid on Nos. 53 to 58 inclusive up to 10/10/56.

"The Treasurer of Titus County is hereby instructed to confirm the notice already given known holders by the J. R. Phillips Investment Company on the payment of principal and interest in accordance with the above order."

The motion was carried and the above order was approved by the Commissioners' Court.

County Commissioner, G. C. Lunsford offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, and made a motion that the same be passed by said court, which motion was seconded by County Commissioner, T. J. Stringfellow. The Order is as follows, to wit:

"It appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that J. T. Leftwich, Tax Assessor and Collector in making his November report to the County Treasurer, turned in to said treasurer the sum of \$73.00 in General County Script which he had accepted on taxes, and at the same time turned in \$73.00 in cash, and in making his January Report he turned in to said County Treasurer the sum of \$4,042.60 in General County Script which he had accepted on General County Taxes, and at the same time turned in to said treasurer the sum of \$4,042.60 in cash, making in all \$4,115.60, which is an excess amount paid into the County Treasurer by said Tax Collector. It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that G. W. McLemore, County Treasurer of Titus County, Texas, pay to J. T. Leftwich, Tax Assessor and Collector of Titus County, the said sum of \$4,115.60 out of the County Treasurer's Fund of Titus County."

The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "No" County Commissioners, G. C. Lunsford, T. J. Stringfallow, W. J. Gody and Ernest Brown all voted "Aye" None voted "No" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

County Commissioner, G. O. Lunsford offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, and made a motion that the same be passed by eaid court, which motion was seconded by County Commissioner, Ernast Brown. The order is as follows, towit:

"It appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that there is an excess of money in the Permanent Improvement Fund of Titus County, and that it is necessary and for the best interest of Titus County to borrow from said Permanent Improvement Fund the sum of \$500.00 and place same in the Operating Fund of Titus County."

The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "Mo" all of the members of said court voted "Aye". The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
