## SPECIAL SESSION

BE IT REMEMBERED that on this the 14th day of August 1937 the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas met in Special Session at the Court House in Mt. Pleasant, Texas, with the following members present to-wit: G. C. Lunsford, W. J. Cody and T. J. Stringfellow, Commissioners, and C. T. Neugent, County Judge, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

It is ordered by the Commissioners Court that Dr. D. M. Witt, S.A. Newman, Jesse Newman and Jim Morrie be and they are hereby appointed to contact the property owners on resurveyed route for re-location of State Highway #49 between Mt. Pleasant, Texas and Sulphur River in Titus Co. in order to acquire and purchase the right-of-way necessary; such person or persons shall make an effort to acquire or purchase said right-of-way and report back to this Court on the matter.

County Commissioner G. C. Lunsford made a motion, that the above order be passed, which motion was seconded by Co. Commissioner W. J. Cody. The Co. Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "aye" and those opposed to vote "no". Commissioners G. C. Lunsford, T. J. Stringfellow and W. J. Cody all voted "aye" and none voted "no." County Judge C. T. Neugent declared the motion carried and the order passed.
