and passes the following order:

IT APPEARING THAT heretofore on or about the 13th day of May, 1935, the Commissioners Court of Titus County authorised the issuance of \$90,000 Titus County 5% Road Refunding Bonde, Series I, dated April 10, 1935, for the purpose of refunding an equal amount of them outstanding

road bonds of Titus County;

AND IT FURTHER APPEARING THAT serial numbers 1 and 2 of such refunding bonds, \$1000 each, maturing April 10, 1925, are past due and have not been registered by the Comptroller nor delivered in exchange for the surrender and cancellation of the bonds for the refunding of which they are made ready, and that the \$2,000.00 original bonds which were intended to be refunded by the hereinbefore described serial numbers 1 and 2 of the refunding bonds have been paid off, and that therefore said two refunding bonds should be cancelled:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS
COUNTY, TEXAS, that the hereinbefore described Titus County Road Refunding Bonds Serial Nos.

1 and 2, \$1000 each, maturing April 10, 1936, be and they are hersby camelled, and the Comptroller of Public Accounts of the State of Texas and/or the County Judge of Titus County and/or the County Treasurer of Titus County are hereby authorized and requested to cancel said bonds and return them to the County Treasurer of Titus County, that the County Treasurer of Titus
County may correct his records accordingly.

The foregoing order having been read, it was moved by Commissioner G. C. Lunsford, and seconded by Commissioner T. J. Stringfellow, that the same be passed, and upon the question being called, it was unanimously passed, Commissioners STRINGFELLOW, CODY, and LUNSFORD voting yes: and no one voting NO.
