Motion was made by County Commissioner Geo. Lunsford and seconded by County Commissioner Brown to approve the monthly expense account and report of H. E. Wilhite, Justice of the Peace. The motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by County Commissioner Brown and seconded by County Commissioner Cody to approve the monthly expense account of Morris Rolston, County Attorney. The motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by County Commissioner Lunsford and seconded by County Commissioner Brown to allow a refund of \$33.33 to J. T. Leftwich. The motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by County Commissioner Lunsford and seconded by County Commissioner Stringfellow to approve the monthly expense account of J. T. Leftwich, Tax Assessor-Collector. The motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by County Commissioner Lunsford and seconded by County Commissioner Brown to allow a public road according to the petition set out below, and the motion carried unanimously:

BE IT REMEMBERED that there came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County at its meeting held in the Court House thereof on the 13 day of December, 1937, the matter of paying the awards in condemnation suits filed on October 26, 1937 in the matter of re-location of State Highway No. 49 in Titus County. Commissioner Lunsford offered the following order and moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Cody. Commissioners Lunsford, Cody, and County Judge C. T. Neugent all voted "aye" and T. J. Stringfellow and Ernest Brown voted "no". The motion carried and the order was declared by the County Judge as passed and adopted. The order is as follows:

It is ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that the County Clerk of Titus County, Texas be and he is hereby authorized and instructed to pay for Titus County out of the Road and Bridge Fund of said County the awards made by the Special Commissioners in condemnation suits Nos. 1431 to 1438, inclusive, such proceedings filed October 26, 1937 and awards filed November 26, 1937: PROVIDED, that where objections to such awards have been filed in such cases within the statutory ten (10) days after the filing of such awards as provided by Art. 3266, then, in such event and in such cases, said County Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and instructed to withdraw from the said Road and Bridge Fund of said County a sum of money equivalent to the awards in such cases and deposit the amount of each award in each of such appealed cases in County Court, subject to the order of the defendants in such cases.

It is further ordered that the said County Clerk of Titus County, Texas be and he is hereby authorized and instructed also to pay the costs awarded against Titus County, Texas in the above mentioned condemnation proceedings out of the said Road and Bridge Fund of said County.

Motion was made by County Commissioner G. C. Lunsford, and seconded by County Commissioner Ernest Brown that the Operating fund of Titus County borrow from the Trial Fee fund of said county the sum of \$400.00. All members voted aye and the motion carried unanimately.

Be it remembered that the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, met in regular session on Dec. 14, 1937, with C. T. Neugent, County Judge, Commissioners, Stringfellow, Lunsford, Cody and Brown, present,

When came up to be considered the application of C. S. D. #19, Titus County, Texas, for permission to pay its bonds held by permanent school fund of Titus County, Texas.

It appears to the Court that said application is meritorious and should be

granted.

It is, therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, that Common School District No. 19 of Titus County, Texas, may pay its bonds as it accumulates the money to do so until it shall have paid its bonds owned by the Permanent School fund of Titus County, Texas.

All members voted "aye" and the motion carried and the order passed unanimously.
