Motion was made by Commissioner G. C. Lunsford and seconded by Commissioner T. J. Stringfellow that the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, make application to the First National Bank in Mt. Pleasant, for a loan amounting to \$6000.00; said amount of money to be paid to the holders of county warrants issued by the County Clerk of Titus County, Texas, upon the Road and Bridge Fund of Titus County.

The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court, and upon a unanimous vote of the Commissioners, the motion carried and the order was passed.
