IN THE MATTER OF PURCHASING BONDS FOR PERMANENT SCHOOL FUND:

By direction of the Trustees for Common School District No. 10 of Titus County, Texas, I offer you the School House Bonds of said district, dated September 10th, 1929, numbered from 10 to 17, both inclusive, in denominations of \$100.00 each, bearing 5% interest from date, payable annually on April 10., aggregating the sum of \$800,00 and assrued interest for their par value plus accrued interest, as an investment for the permanent school fund of Titus County, Texas.

Be it remembered that the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, met in regular sassion at the Court House of Titus County, Texas, on the 12th, day of September A.D. 1986 with the County Judge of Titus County, Texas, and all members of the Commissioners Court present.

When, County Commissioner, Lunsford, offered the following order to the Commission-

ers Court of Titus County, Texas, and made a motion that the same be passed by the Court, which motion was seconded by County Commissioner, Stringfellow. The order in word and figures is, to wit:

It appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that the School House Bonds of Common School District No. 10 of Titus County, Texas, numbered 10 to 17, both inclusive, in denominations of \$100.00 each bearing 5% interest from date payable annually on April 10th. each year, aggregating \$800.00 and accrued interest have been offered by said School District through its authorized agents to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, as an investment of the permanent school fund of said County. That the permanent school fund of said County has the funds with which to purchase said bonds.

It is therefored, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that the said offer be and the same is accepted and that each bonds be purchased by the Permanent School Fund of Titus County, Texas, at the price of the par value and accrued interest. The Clerk of the County Court of said County will issue his warrant against the permanent school fund of said County to said School district for the amount of the par value and accrued interest of said bonds.

The County Judge put the said motion and order for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with the request that as many as favored the motion and the order would vote "AYE". and those opposed would vote "NO". Whereupon all of the members of the Court voted "AYE."

The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF SETTING THE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 1958:

At a regular asssion of the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas Motion was made by W. J. Cody, Commissioner, and seconded by Commissioner Ernest Brown that tax rates for Titus County for the year 1938 be set as follows hersin. The said motion was put to a vote and the entire Commissioners' Court being present voted in the affirmative.

It is ordered by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County that, for the purpose of creating a special fund to retire ecunty sorip-issued in the year 1934 and prior years, there is hereby levied Three (5g) cents on the one hundred dollars valuation of all properties in Titus County authorized for county general purposes by Article 8, sec. 9 of the Constitution of Texas, which shall be assessed and collected by the Assessor and Collector and shall be set aside as a Special Fund to retire the said county general scrip validly issued for the year 1934 and prior years under the terms of an order of the Commissioners' Court made on the 15th day of August 1936.

For county general purposes there is hereby levied Twenty-two (22%) cents on all taxable property in Titus County for the County General Fund for the year 1938.

There is hereby lewied for Road and Bridge Fund a tax of Fifteen (15¢) cents on the one hundred dollars valuation of all taxable property in Titus County for the year 1938.

There is hereby levied for the jury fund Ten (10%) cents on the one hundred dollars valuation of all taxable property in Titus County for the year 1938.

There is hereby levied for the Permanent Improvement Fund Twenty-five (25%) cents on the one hundred deblars valuation of all taxable property in Titus County for the year 1938, to go into a permanent fund to build a court house for Titus County.

There is hereby levied a Special Road interest and einking fund of Seventy (70\$) cents on the one hundred valuation of all taxable property in Titus County for the year 1938

There is hereby levied for the Common School Districts in Titus County, Texas a tax on all properties located in the several common school districts in Titus County for the year 1938, as set out below, to-wit:
