

IN THE MATTER OF CREATING A FUND TO PAY COUNTY SCRIP FOR YEARS PRIOR:

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT, the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, held a regular session of said court in the City of Mount Pleasant, Texas, on the 15 day of September A.D. 1938, with the following members of said court, present, to-wit:

- O. T. Neugent, County Judge of Titus County, Presiding.
- T. J. Stringfellow, Commissioner of Precinct No. 1.
- Wm. Cody, Commissioner of Precinct No. 2.
- Ernest Brown, Commissioner of Precinct No. 3.
- G.C. Lunsford, Commissioner of Precinct No. 4.

The court considered the matter of outstanding scrip warrants issued against the county's general fund, and the following facts appeared:

(1) In the general county fund, there is now on hand in cash, the amounts below stated, which amounts were collected from taxes for the years indicated, to-wit:

(2) For the years of 1935 and 1936, the amount of cash on hand is sufficient to pay all scrip warrants issued for said years against the general county fund, with an excess of \$2828.62.

(3) That against said \$2828.62 excess for the years of 1935 and 1936, there has been charged a check for \$2000.00 paid upon a judgment rendered against Titus County in the United States District Court at Texarkana on funding warrants, leaving a net excess for said years of \$828.62.

(4) That after deducting sufficient money to pay all scrip warrants drawn against the general county fund for the years of 1935 and 1936, and letting 1937 remain current, without in any way changing the present manner of handling said fund in so far as 1937 is concerned, there is no on hand in the general fund of this county \$4068.92, representing tax collections for the years of 1930, 1931, 1932, 1933 and 1934, and the above mentioned excess from 1935 and 1936.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT AS FOLLOWS:

(1) That all taxes levied on account of the general county fund for 1937, be applied to the payment of scrip warrants issued for the same year; and in the event there remains any amount of money for said year, after the payment of such warrants, said amount shall be treated as an excess and is hereby transferred to the fund hereinafter set up for the payment of warrants issued for the year of 1934 and prior years.

(2) Out of the taxes collected for the years of 1935 and 1936 on account of the general county fund, the treasurer of this county is directed to hold a sufficient sum of money to pay all scrip warrants issued for said years, and to deduct the \$2000.00 paid on the Federal Court Judgment above mentioned. The balance on hand for said years is hereby transferred to the fund hereinafter set up for the payment of warrants issued for the year of 1934 and prior years.

(3) The above mentioned excess for the years of 1935 and 1936, and all sums collected for the years of 1934 and all prior years shall be placed in one fund, and applied to the payment of warrants issued for 1934 and prior years in the order of their registration, beginning with the oldest registered warrant.
