

SPECIAL SESSION

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 30th day of September, 1938, Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas met in a special session at the Court House of said County in the City of Mt. Pleasant, Texas with the following members present, to-wit:

There came on to be considered the matter of payment of certain script warrants issued by the said Titus County, Texas to land owners abutting the re-located State Highway No. 49 between White Oak Creek and Mt. Pleasant, Texas in said County in payment for the fencing of the right-of-way for said State Highway No. 49.

Commissioner Lunsford presented for consideration an order and moved its adoption. Said motion was seconded by Commissioner Stringfellow. After reading said order and after the Court had duly considered and discussed the same, the County Judge put the motion for a vote to the members of said Court and said vote was as follows:

AYES: Commissioners Lunsford, Stringfellow, Cody, and Brown.

NOES: None.

The said order is in words and figures as follows, to-wit:

AN ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT TO THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK IN MT. PLEASANT, TEXAS OF THE AMOUNTS OF CERTAIN SCRIPT WARRANTS OF SAID COUNTY ISSUED AUGUST 30, 1938 IN PAYMENT FOR FENCING ALONG THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF RE-LOCATED STATE HIGHWAY NO. 49 AND DRAWN UPON THE ROAD AND BRIDGE FUND OF SAID COUNTY AND AGGREGATING THE PRINCIPAL SUM OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED TWENTY THREE AND 52/100 (\$1823.52) DOLLARS, WHICH WARRANTS HAVE BEEN OR MAY HEREAFTER BE PAID BY THE SAID BANK TO THE HOLDERS OF SAID WARRANTS AS PRESENTED AT SAID BANK FOR PAYMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF INTEREST THEREON FROM THE DATE OF PAYMENT BY SAID BANK OF EACH OF SAID WARRANTS AT THE RATE OF 6% PER ANNUM; AND PLEDGING TO SAID BANK THE FIRST REVENUES RECEIVED BY AND DUE SAID COUNTY FROM THE AUTOMOBILE REGISTRATIONS AND LICENSES PAYMENTS FOR AUTOMOBILES DUE AND PAYABLE FOR THE YEAR 1938 FOR THE PAYMENT AND RETIREMENT OF SAID SCRIPT WARRANTS PAID AND TO BE PAID BY SAID BANK, TOGETHER WITH SAID INTEREST THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, on the 30th day of August, 1938, certain script warrants were ordered and issued by Titus County, Texas in payment for fencing done and to be done along the right-of-way of re-located State Highway No. 49 between Mt. Pleasant, Texas and White Oak Creek, which script warrants are described as follows, to-wit:

WHEREAS, said Titus County is obligated to do such fencing and the expenditures indicated by said warrants are necessary and reasonable and same are valid obligations upon the Road and Bridge Fund of said County; and

WHEREAS, there are not sufficient funds now on hand in said Road and Bridge Fund to pay said warrants and said warrants are unpaid, and The First National Bank in Mt. Pleasant, Texas, being the depository for said County, has and will in due course have such warrants presented to it for payment; and

WHEREAS, it is contemplated that said County will receive about the month of April 1938, prior thereto and thereafter certain funds and monies as its part or portion due for automobile licenses and registration in said County for said year and which will become a part of the Road and Bridge Fund of said County.

NOW, THEREFORE, be, and it is, hereby ordered by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas that there be and is hereby pledged unto The First National Bank in Mt. Pleasant, Texas, its successors and assigns, the first monies and revenues due and owing and that may be paid and collected as the County's part or portion of the automobile licenses and/or registration fees for and on automobiles paid in said County for the year 1938 from and with which to re-pay said Bank for the amounts of the above mentioned script warrants, with interest as herein provided, which said Bank has paid or may hereafter pay to the holders thereof; said Commissioners' Court hereby obligating said County to pay unto The First National Bank in Mt. Pleasant, Texas the amount of its aforesaid script warrant obligations which said Bank has paid or may hereafter pay unto the holders thereof, together with interest upon each of said warrants from the date of the paying of same by said Bank to the holders thereof at the rate of 6% per annum.
