On this the 10th day of Oct., 1938, the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, being convened in Regular Term thereof, with the following members of the Court present, to-wit:

with the following members absent, to-wit: None, constituting a quorum of the Court, at which time the following among other business was transacted:

Commissioner Brown introduced a proposed order and made a motion that it be passed. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lunsford. The motion carrying with it the passage of the order prevailed by the following vote:

AYES: Commissioners Stringfellow, Gedy, Brown and Lunsford.

NOES: None.

The order as passed is as follows:

AN ORDER

FIXING DATE FOR HEARING ON THE PETITION FOR THE
ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY ROAD DISTRICT NO. THREE.

WHEREAS, there came on to be considered the petition of - - and 149 other persons praying the Court to order an election to determine

"Whether or not the bonds of Road District No. Three shall be issued in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand (\$200,000.00) Dollars, bearing interest at the rate of not to exceed five and one-half (5½%) per cent per annum, payable semi-annually and maturing at such times as may be fixed by the Commissioners' Court serially or otherwise, in not to exceed thirty (30) years from the date thereof, for the purpose of the construction, maintenance, and operation of macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof, throughout Road District No. three and whether or not an ad valorem tax shall be levied on all taxable property in said Road District No. One sufficient to pay the annual interest and to provide a sinking fund sufficient to redeem said bonds at their maturity."

; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Court and is so adjudged that said petition is signed by at least fifty (50) of the resident, property tax paying voters residing in said District; and

WHEREAS, said Road District has heretofore been legally created by the Commissioners' Court by order duly entered on the 10th day of Oct., 1938, which order is of record in the Minutes of the Commissioners' Court, Volume --, Page -- et seq;

BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That a hearing shall be had by this Court at the Court House in the City of Mt. Pleasant on said petition on the 28th day of Oct., 1938, which date is not less than fifteen (15) nor more than thirty (30) days from the date of this order;
2. The Clerk of this Court shall forthwith issue a notice of the time and place of hearing, which notice shall inform all persons concerned of the time and place of hearing and of their right to appear at such hearing and contend for or protest the ordering of such bond election;
3. Such notice shall state the amount of the bonds proposed to be issued, and shall describe the road district by its number, and shall describe the boundaries thereof as contained in the order establishing the district;
4. The Clerk shall execute said notice, posting true copies thereof in three public places within said road district and one at the Court House door of the County. Said notice shall be posted for at least ten (10) days prior to the date of said hearing. Said notice shall also be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the subdivision or district, if a newspaper is published therein, one time, and at least five days prior to such hearing. If no newspaper is published in such district, then such notice shall be published in some newspaper in the County if there be one; the duties herein imposed on the Clerk may be performed by the Clerk in person, or by the deputy;
5. Said hearing shall be conducted under the provisions of Chapter 16, Acts of the First Called Session of the 39th Legislature; and pertinent amendments thereto;
6. The notes and bounds of Road District No. Three as created by Commissioners' Court on the 10th day of Oct., 1938, are as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at the N. E. corner of Titus County, Texas; THENCE in a Westerly direction along the North Boundary line of the County to the Northwest corner of the County; THENCE in southerly direction along the West Boundary line of Titus County to the intersection of the West Boundary line of the County and White Oak Creek; THENCE in a Southeasterly direction with the meanders of White Oak Creek to the East Boundary line of Titus County; THENCE in a Northerly direction along the East Boundary line of the County to the Northeast corner of Titus County and the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS:

We, the undersigned resident, property tax paying voters residing within the territory which has been designated by the Commissioners' Court as "ROAD DISTRICT NO. THREE OF TITUS COUNTY TEXAS", described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at the S. E. corner of Titus County, Texas; Thence in a Westerly direction along the North Boundary line of the County to the Northwest corner of the County; Thence in a Southerly direction along the West Boundary line of Titus County to the intersection of the West Boundary line of the County and White Oak Creek; Thence in a Southeasterly direction with the meanders of White Oak Creek to the East Boundary line of Titus County; Thence in a Northerly direction along the East Boundary line of the County to the Northeast corner of Titus County and the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Respectfully petition the Court to order an election in said District to determine the following proposition:

"Whether or not the bonds of said road district shall be issued in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand (\$200,000.00) Dollars, bearing interest at the rate of not to exceed five and one half per cent (5½) per annum, payable semi-annually, and maturing at such times as

may be fixed by the Commissioners' Court serially or otherwise, in not to exceed thirty (30) years from the date thereof, for the purpose of the construction, maintenance and operation of macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof, through Road District No. Three and whether or not an ad valorem tax shall be levied on all taxable property in Road District No. Three sufficient to pay the annual interest and to provide a sinking fund sufficient to redeem said bonds at their maturity.
