IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING THE COUNTY DEPOSITORY PLEDGE CONTRACT:

Motion was made by Commissioner Lunsford and seconded by Commissioner Gody to approve the County Depository Pledge Contract of the First National Bank in Mt. Pleasant. All present voted "aye" and the motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM JURY FUND TO OPERATING FUND:

It appearing to the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, that there is a surplus in the Jury Fund of Titus County, and that it is necessary and to the best interest of Titus County for the Operating Fund of Titus County to borrow funds from the Jury Fund, BE IT ORDERED that the sum of \$500.00 be transferred from the Jury Fund to the Operating Fund and the County Clerk is hereby directed to issue a warrant on said Jury Fund, payable to the Operating Fund for said amount.

Motion was made by Commissioner Lunsford and seconded by Commissioner Gody to pass the above order. All present voted "aye" and the motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING SCHOOL DEPOSITORY BOND:

Motion was made by Commissioner Lunsford and seconded by Commissioner Gody to approve the School Depository Bond of the First National Bank of Mt. Pleasant, Texas. All present voted "aye" and the motion carried.
