WHEREAS, during the 1st. half of April, 1939, I was driving and operating a vehicle drawn by a horse on the road

And Whereas, while I was driving the horse up a hill, a truck owned by Titus County, Texas, and driven by one of its employees came over the hill and ran into me.

And whereas I suffered serious bodily injuries and a great deal of pain, and had to be carried to the Doctor's office for medical treatment and the bill I now owe the Doctor amounts to the sum of \$40.50,

And whereas said injury has rendered me unfit for work to this present time.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM SOUTHERLAND, of the County of Titus and State of Texas, in consideration of \$40.00 in cash paid to me this day by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, the receipt of which is hereby fully acknowledged and confessed, and the assumption of the Doctor's Bill, of \$40.50, by the said Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, do hereby remise, release all and forever quitclaim to the County of Titus, acting through and by its Commissioners' Court, any and all claims that I may have arising from said injury received by me as the result of the collision between the horse drawn vehicle driven by me and the truck owned by Titus Co and driven by an employee of the W.P.A.

IN THE MATTER OF ORDERING PURCHASE OF \$2000 TITUS COUNTY ROAD BONDS: JUNE 12, 1939.

It is hereby ordered by the Commissioners' Court of Titus Co. Texas, that the County purchase with its County-Wide Road Bond Sinking Fund, \$2000.00 Titus Co. Road Dist. #1 5% Road Bonds, maturing April 10, 1946 from the J. R. Phillips Investment Co., Houston, at a price to yield 2.40% plus accrued interest.

The Co. Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay \$2,397.50 upon the above described bonds, being presented for payment.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS, that the contract entered into by and between the County of Titus and C. N. Burt & Company, Dallas, Texas, on the 10th day of January, 1939, be cancelled and repealed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the order passed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, on the 14th day of January 1939, and as amended on the 16th day of February, 1939, authorizing and directing the County Treasurer to deposit all collected proceedings from the 1938 Road and Bridge tax levy, to a Special Account to be held subject to further orders of the Court pending the outcome of a refunding of the Road and Bridge Warrants, both be repealed.
