

## SPECIAL SESSION

The Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, in session at the Court House of said County on June 26th, 1939, with all members present:

When came on to be considered the matter of investing the Permanent School fund of Titus County in the bonds of Maple Springs Common School District No. 2 of Titus County Texas and that there is sufficient money on hand at this time to purchase 3 of said Bonds.

It is therefore ordered by the Commissioner's Court of Titus County Texas that Bonds Nos. 20, 19, and 18 in denominations of \$1250.00 each dated Sept. 1, 1938, of Maple Springs Common School District No. 2 of Titus County Texas be purchased by the Permanent School Fund of Titus County, Texas, at their par value of \$3750.00 and that accrued interest thereon be adjusted by cancelling the first interest coupon and credit of interest accrued on interest coupon No. 2 of each of said bonds.

The Clerk of this Court will issue warrant against said permanent school fund for \$3750.00 in payment for said bonds.
