WHERRAS, I. C. T. Neugent, county Judge of Titus County, Texas, find said petitions in proper from as required by law, and that there is a sufficient number of legally qualified voters signing the same, and;

WHERRAS, Ripley Common School District No. 17, Titus County, Texas, and Talco Independent School District of Titus County, Texas, are contiguous districts, as required by law, and Titus County has jurisdiction over the principal school in such district, NOW:

THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, C. T. Heugent, County Judge of Titus County, Texas, in compliance with said petitions and by virtue of Art. 2806, R. C. S. 1925, do hereby call an election to be held within the boundaries of Ripley Common School District No. 17, Titus County, Texas, and Talco Independent School District, Titus County, Texas, on the 31st day of August, A.D. for the purpose of submitting to a vote of the legally qualified coters residing in said districts the question of the consolidation of Ripley Common School District No. 17 and Talco Independent School District.

BE IT FURTHER ordered that the ballots for the consolidation of Talco Independent
School District and Hipley Common School District No. 17 shall have printed thereon the following words:

FOR CONSCIDATION OF RIPLEY COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 17 AND TALCO INDEPENDANT SCHOOL DISTRICT.

"AGAINST CONSOLIDATION OF RIPLEY COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 17 AND TALCO INDEPENDANT SCHOOL DISTRICT."

BE IT FURTHER ordered that notice of this election be given by posting one copy of such notice in each of said districts.
